### **About this Form**

This form is used to make an application to the District Court for a Domestic Violence Order.

• **Domestic violence** includes, but is not limited to, any act or threat of physical, sexual, or emotional violence, or coercive control. **This is also often referred to as domestic abuse.** Domestic violence also includes acts and threats of a financial or digital nature.



Please note that this form is only to be used if you are making your application in the Dublin Metropolitan District (Dublin District Court Family Law Office only) or in Cork City (District No. 19).

The Court can make Domestic Violence orders that take your safety, and the safety of any dependent children, into consideration.

- A Barring Order directs the respondent to leave, or not enter, your home. It may also direct
  the respondent to stop using, or threatening to use, violence against you, and to stop following
  or communicating with you. A Barring Order granted by the District Court can last for up to 3
  years.
- A **Safety Order** may direct the respondent to stop using, or threatening to use, violence against you, and to stop following or communicating with you. If the respondent is living with you, it does not order them to leave the home. If the respondent is not living with you, it may direct them to stay away from your home. A Safety Order granted by the District Court can last for up to 5 years.

#### **Interim Domestic Violence Orders Sought**

- An Interim Barring Order can offer the same protections as a Barring Order for a maximum of 8 working days. If you want to apply for an Interim Barring Order, you must also apply for a Barring Order, or a Barring Order and a Safety Order in Section C of this form.
